Accessibility work is considered across learning modules, web simulations, classroom tools, flight logs, race timers, support documentation, and administrative workflows.

Standards-aware reporting

Rocket Drones uses VPAT-style accessibility conformance reporting to help customers evaluate support for WCAG, Revised Section 508, and EN 301 549 requirements.

Practical evaluation

Evaluation may include manual review, keyboard navigation checks, screen reader review, semantic structure checks, automated tooling, browser testing, and documentation review.

Continuous improvement

Accessibility is reviewed as the product evolves. New interface patterns, learning content, simulations, and administrative tools may be evaluated as part of future releases.
